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- 1) No wood cutting boards allowed
- 2) Booth space (size 10' X 20') is on a first come first serve basis. Limited to space available.
(Booth not provided, space only)
- 3) Booth set up Friday, January 17th from 10 am – 7pm / On Saturday, Jan. 18th 6am - 9am
- 4) No vehicles inside grounds after 9am on Saturday, Jan. 18th. After 9 am vehicles will be towed at owner's expense.
- 5) No vehicles allowed on grounds to **load up** equipment until all Menudo Bowl Awards are handed out – approximately 7:00 pm
- 6) LIFE will lock gates Saturday night, January 18, 2020 after the event at 9:00pm All items not cleared out at that time may be picked up the next day from 8am – 12:00pm. Items left at owner's risk.
- 7) Representative **must** attend Vendor meeting **Wednesday, January 8, 2020** L.I.F.E. Downs **5:30 pm** to pick up 5 passes, map and get rules from Laredo Crime Stoppers and Webb County Fire Department
- 8) Vendor receives all proceeds from sales.
- 9) No “Soft Drinks, Bottle Water or Alcoholic Beverages” may be brought in, Failure to Comply “Will Warrant” being removed from grounds”. We appreciate your cooperation and participation and ask you to support our concession stands. Water for cooking is permissible
- 10) Vendors must supply own extension cords, tables, chairs and etc. Booth area is to be kept clean at all times.
- 11) Crime Stoppers reserves the right to refuse the use of any banner/sign displaying the name of any product that is in conflict with a current sponsorship. Contact the Crime Stoppers office if you have questions about your banner/sign being in compliance. All participants are restricted to placing banners/signs in any area unless Crime Stoppers has given permission.
- 12) Security will be provided Friday night from 9pm till Saturday 7pm. Laredo Crime Stoppers is “NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS, THEFTS, AND/OR DAMAGE OR INJURY TO PERSONS AND/OR EQUIPMENT”.
- 13) Political material can only be distributed from a candidate's sponsored team booth or paid candidate's booth and not passed out on grounds. Laredo Crime Stoppers, Inc. does NOT endorse any political candidates, campaigns or causes or at federal, state and local levels at any time or in any manner.
- 14) Only two (2) items per booth may be sold and must be approved by Crime Stoppers Committee. Additional items may be sold with a charge of \$150 per item. Items sold must be limited to items listed on application. Failure to comply may result in your removal from grounds.
- 15) Cooking equipment must be 3ft away from the front of the booth or to the back of the booth.
- 16) Duplication of items sold must be approved by Menudo Bowl Committee. First come / first paid basis will apply.
- 17) A (2) two feet fire lane must be between each booth. Fire Lane must remain clear at all times.
- 18) No one under the age of 15 is allowed inside the cooking area.

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- 19) Must bring your own trashcan for your booth.
- 20) Must follow Laredo/Webb County Health Codes.
- 21) 110 volt electrical outlets will be provided for appliances.
- 22) Every booth must have a 5 lb ABC type Fire Extinguisher; if frying with oil a “K” type extinguisher will be required along with the ABC type. Fire Department Ordinance must be complied with. All booths are subject to inspection by the Webb County Fire Department.
- 23) To dispose of cooking oils, place in a disposable container and put in dumpster. Do not throw oil, charcoals or any type of food on the ground after event or you will be restricted from future Menudo Bowl events.
- 24) Each food booth will be given a form that must be signed by and given to _____ after your booth has been inspected in order to receive the \$50.00 clean up fee. Refunds will be disbursed one week after Menudo Bowl.
- 25) Failure to comply with any of the rules mentioned above may result in your removal from grounds.
